

CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH WATERWAYS HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATIONS ADVISORY BOARD TO CHANGE ITS NAME TO THE CORAL GABLES WATERFRONT COMMUNITIES HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION BOARD.

WHEREAS, the City Commission established this City advisory board comprised of representatives from various homeowners' associations from communities located along the waterways in the southern areas of the City so that the board members may provide City staff and the City Commission with their unique perspective regarding concerns common to such communities that include security, waterway use, and traffic and road issues; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission previously established a City advisory board known as the Waterways Advisory Board to address the concerns of the City's waterways and coastal areas, the residents who live along the waterways and coastal areas, and those who regularly use the waterways and coastal areas; and

WHEREAS, because the South Waterways Homeowners Associations Advisory Board has a substantially similar name to that of the Waterways Advisory Board, the former wishes to change its name to distinguish them more easily from the latter, and to clarify that its focus goes beyond that of the waterways and includes all the concerns of the relevant homeowners' associations; and

WHEREAS, on May 14, the South Waterways Homeowners Association Advisory Board voted to recommend to the City Commission that the Board's name be changed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the South Waterways Homeowners' Associations Advisory Board recommends that the City Commission rename the board the, "Coral Gables Waterfront Communities Homeowners' Association Board".

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
