





Like the broad range of media they use, their styles and aesthetic visions are distinctive. Each has a unique message to share, and all use their own language. A particular highlight in this regard is our newest acquisition, Brad Howe's stainless steel Semillitas, which dates to 2005. Nestled into a leafy green interior courtyard at the U's Miami Herbert Business School, this sculpture is both engaging and uplifting, thought-provoking and inspiring ... it is, in a word, the embodiment of creativity!

We hope that you will enjoy your walk and that, while you are enjoying UM's Sculpture Park, you will visit its Lowe Art Museum. Founded in 1950, the Lowe is our region's first art museum. 
