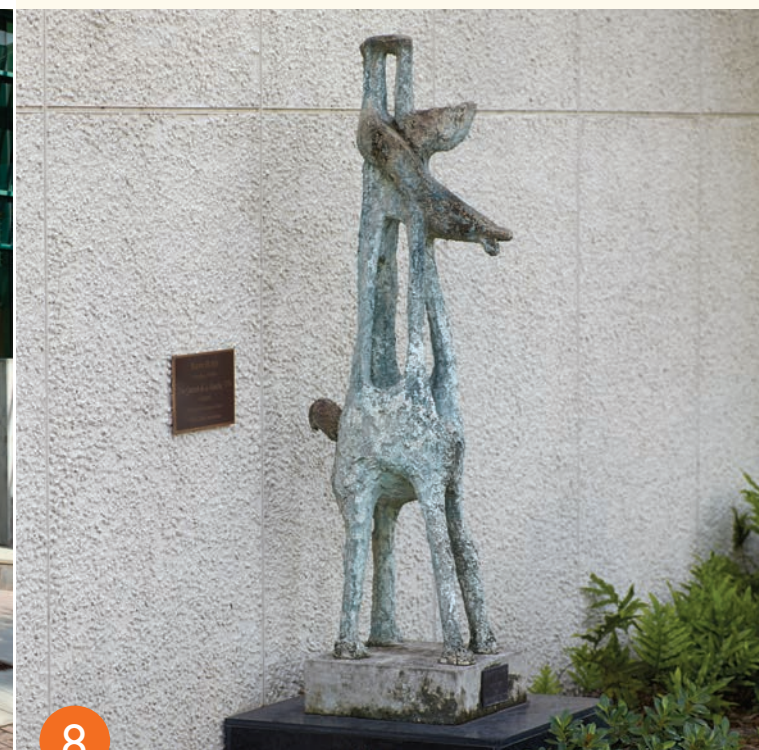

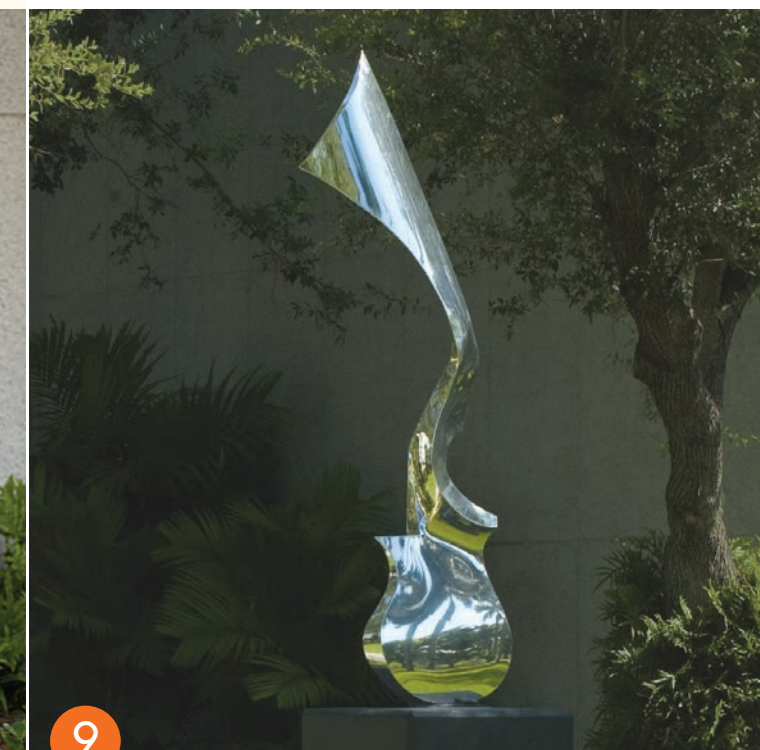

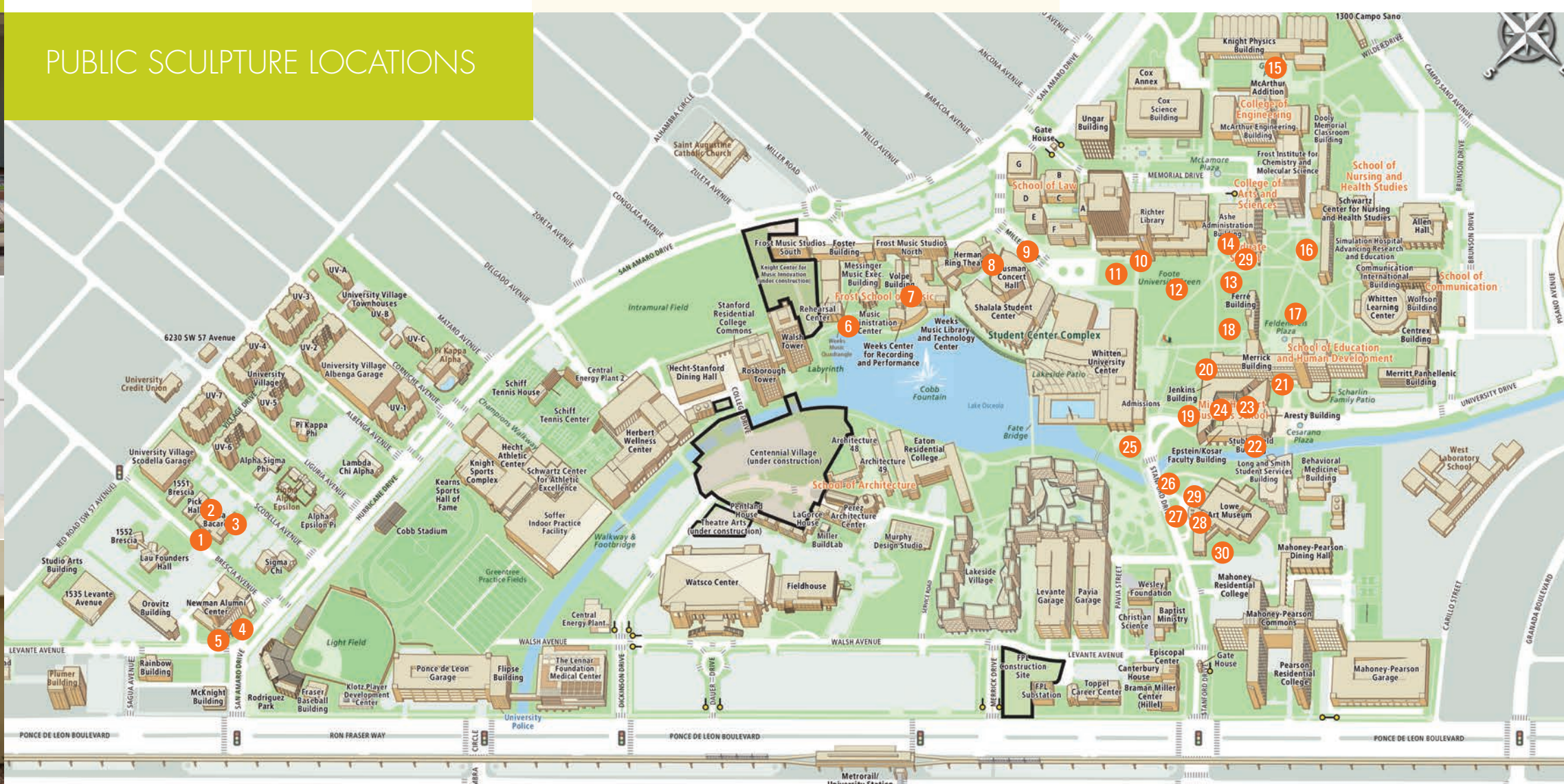

Introduction to the Public Sculpture Collection

CREATIVITY. This fundamentally human trait is tied directly to both cognition and emotion. Creativity fuels innovation, ingenuity, and novel problem-solving in addition to fostering mental agility, responsiveness, grit, and resilience. It has also been linked to an enhanced sense of well-being and emotional clarity. Clearly, creativity has a critical role to play in higher education. It also contributes in manifold ways to building stronger communities and improving overall quality of life. And there is no better place to advance and support creativity than on the University of Miami's beautiful campus, home to its important Sculpture Park. Boasting 30 large-scale outdoor works of art in a salubrious setting, this public asset is available for all to enjoy.

Walking the lush grounds of the U and using this map as your guide, you will have the opportunity to engage directly with works created by leading 20th- and 21st-century artists from across North America, South America, and Europe. Like the broad range of media they use, their styles and aesthetic visions are distinctive. Each has a unique message to share, and all use their own language. A particular highlight in this regard is our newest acquisition, Brad Howe's stainless steel *Semillitas*, which dates to 2005. Nestled into a

leafy green interior courtyard at the U's Miami Herbert Business School, this sculpture is both engaging and uplifting, thought-provoking and inspiring ... it is, in a word, the embodiment of creativity!

We hope that you will enjoy your walk and that, while you are enjoying UM's Sculpture Park, you will visit its Lowe Art Museum. Founded in 1950, the Lowe is our region's first art museum. Its encyclopedic collections represent five millennia of human creativity on every inhabited continent, enabling you to visit the world in a single afternoon. 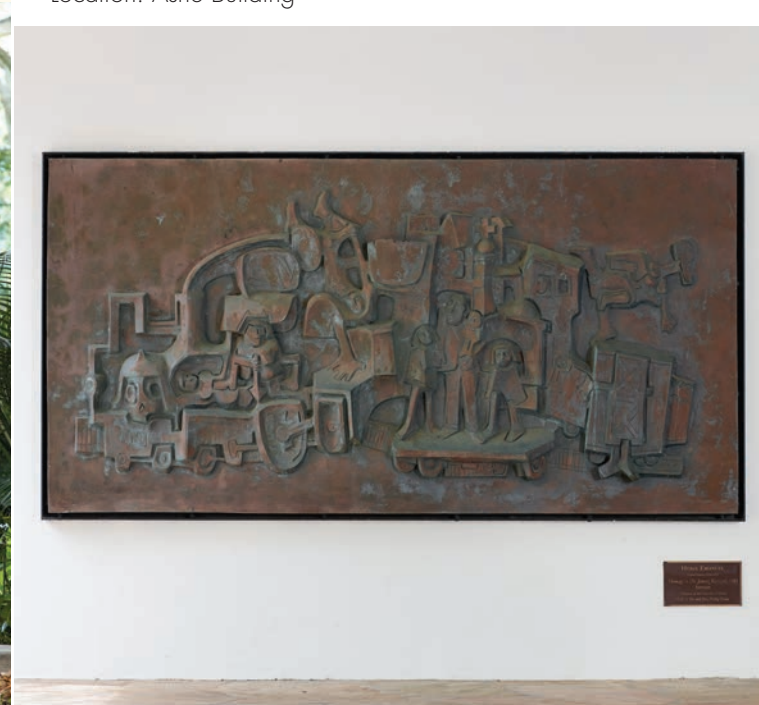
