RESOLUTION NO. 2009-226

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF \$15,000 FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING AND INSTALLING A DIGITAL PAYMENT TECHNOLOGIES MULT-SPACE PAY AND DISPLAY SYSTEM ALONG A PORTION OF SAN AMARO DRIVE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

WHEREAS: The University of Miami is interested in improving the pedestrian traffic flow along San Amaro Drive and from properties west of San Amaro Drive onto the University campus; and

WHEREAS, the existing parking along San Amaro Drive is managed by the City with single space parking meters; and

WHEREAS, the removal of the sixteen (16) single space meters requested by the University will require use of an alternate revenue control system; and

WHEREAS, the University has offered to pay for a multi-space pay and display system to manage the sixteen (16) parking spaces in question; and

WHEREAS, the installation of a multi-space pay and display meter system is consistent with improving the City's on-street revenue control efforts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.




