RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER PURSUANT TO PROCUREMENT CODE SECTION 2-772, SPECIAL PROCUREMENTS/BID WAIVER, TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO GREENBROOK POOLS FOR CERTAIN LIFE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CORAL GABLES COUNTRY CLUB SWIMMING POOL TO BRING THE FACILITY INTO COMPLIANCE WITH THE VIRGINIA GRAEME BAKER POOL AND SPA SAFETY ACT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$80,000).

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2009, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued and distributed the Request For Proposals (RFP) 2009.04.10 for Coral Gables Country Club Pool Project and,

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2009 the Coral Gables Country Club Pool Project was re-advertised under Request For Proposals (RFP) 2009.06.03 and,

WHEREAS, the April 10, 2009 and June 12, 2009 Request For Proposals for the Coral Gables Country Club Pool Project were cancelled as a result of lack of competition and,

WHEREAS, no suitable “Piggyback” contracts from other governmental entities were found to bring the Coral Gables Country Club Pool into compliance with the life safety requirements of the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act and,

WHEREAS, the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act requires certain life safety improvement for the Coral Gables Country Club Pool before it can be re-opened to the public and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. That the City of Coral Gables Commission accept the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer pursuant to Section 2-772 Special Procurements/Bid Waiver to grant a bid waiver to award a contract to Greenbrook Pools to bring the Coral Gables Country Club Pool into compliance with the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act for an amount not to exceed eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000).

Section 2. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
