BRIEF HISTORY:

Ponce de Leon Middle School, founded alongside the City of Coral Gables in the 1920s – known then as Ponce de Leon High School – now stands as one of the oldest educational institutions in the City of Coral Gables. For one hundred years, Ponce de Leon Middle School has provided high-quality education to generations of Coral Gables youth and families, deeply shaping the civic, cultural, and academic life of the community.

Throughout its long history, Ponce de Leon Middle School has remained a vital institution for families in Coral Gables and surrounding communities — evolving with changing educational demands while preserving its traditions of excellence, service, and community.

In recognition of Ponce de Leon Middle School’s one hundred years of educational excellence, service, and community enrichment provided to the residents of the City of Coral Gables, the City Commission wishes to co-designate Augusto Street as “Explorers Way.”
