RESOLUTION NO. 2009-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE CORAL GABLES CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A DEALER DEMONSTRATOR ISUZU EMERGENCY RESCUE TRUCK FROM CUSTOM TRUCKS & BODY WORKS, INC., THE SOLE SOURCE VENDOR, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,000.00 PURSUANT TO PROCUREMENT CODE, SECTION 2-770 "SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT". THIS VEHICLE IS A REPLACEMENT AIR TRUCK TO REFILL THE BREATHING AIR CYLINDERS FOR THE CORAL GABLES FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has a need for a replacement air truck to refill the breathing air cylinders for the firefighters; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2009, an opportunity to purchase a Dealer Demonstrator Isuzu Rescue Truck with approximately 3,000 miles was presented to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City negotiated with Custom Trucks & Body Works Inc. in Woodbury, GA. the purchase price of said Rescue Truck (Vin # JALESW16387901569) to be \$94,995.00 less negotiated \$14,995.00 for a total price of \$80,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City's Automotive Director and Fire Chief attest that this Rescue Truck meets the needs of the department with a cost savings of over \$200,000 and recommend the purchase of said vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City of Coral Gables Commission does hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager pursuant to the Procurement Code, section 2-770 Sole Source Procurement to purchase a used Isuzu Rescue Truck from Custom Trucks and Body Works, Inc., the Sole Source Vendor.

SECTION 3. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.

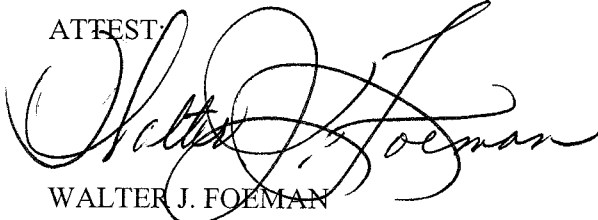
