

## **ITEM TITLE:**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO IMPLEMENT A PILOT PROGRAM PLACING AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (AED) IN ADDITIONAL CITY PARKS, AND A PILOT PROGRAM PLACING CODE BLUE SMART EMERGENCY STATIONS IN CERTAIN CITY PARKS

## **BRIEF HISTORY:**

The City's Fire Department currently manages the City's Public Access Defibrillation program for the City. The City current has over 200 AEDs spread throughout City facilities, parks, CGPD vehicles, Fire Department staff vehicles, and NSA vehicles.

The City is interested in enhancing the availability of AEDs and increasing security measures at those City parks that are not permanently staffed by City personnel. This resolution directs the City Manager to develop two pilot programs, one for AED and Code Smart Emergency Stations at Rotary Park and Salvadore Park, and a second pilot program adding those Code Blue stations to additional City parks. The City Manager is directed to add those pilot programs to the FY 23-24 Budget for approval by the City Commission.
