ITEM TITLE:

A Resolution of the City Commission authorizing the acceptance of modification no. 1 of grant funds to Agreement no. G23MI0016A funds in the amount of \$313,237.79 on behalf of the Coral Gables Police Department as part of the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) Program to support Fiscal Year 2023-2024 operations of the South Florida Money Laundering Strike Force; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 annual budget to recognize the \$313,237.79 grant modification no. 1 as revenue and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the program.

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Office of National Drug Control Policy's (ONDCP) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) program provides assistance to federal, state and local law enforcement agencies in areas determined to be critical drug-trafficking regions of the United States.

The Coral Gables Police Department is a subrecipient of the allocated funds in the amount of \$313,237.79 to support Fiscal Year 2023-2024 operations of the South Florida Money Laundering Strike Force. The original grant amount for Agreement No. G23MI0016A is \$364,032, modification amount is \$313,237.79 with a total award amount of \$677,269.79.

An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$313,237.79 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditure.
