A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ADD SAFETY COUNTERMEASURES TO STATE-OWNED THOROUGHFARES IN CORAL GABLES.

BRIEF HISTORY:

Several state-owned roads run through the City of Coral Gables. City commissioners, staff, and residents have opined that drivers often speed along these routes, creating hazardous conditions for all road and sidewalk users. In tandem with efforts to safeguard roads for users citywide, city commissioners and staff have identified key intersections where safety countermeasures would control traffic speeds, protect motorists and non-motorists, and better direct the flow of traffic. Further, the city commission and staff have also identified locations where the Florida Department of Transportation has planned improvements to streets and intersections to enhance pedestrian safety.
