Transportation Advisory Board meeting minutes of March 17, 2026

**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

- Meeting called to order at 5:30 PM by Roland Rodriguez; quorum was met.
- December meeting minutes approved with minor revisions.
- No public comments.
- Sgt. Diaz provided no police update.

**Transportation & Mobility Updates**

- Matthew Anderson reported increased trolley ridership and the addition of the City's 14th trolley vehicle.
- Last Mile Transit project has been completed; staff is finalizing DOT grant documentation.
- Updates on Freebee and Bird services were provided.
- Roland Rodriguez shared an e-bike safety flyer and discussed e-bike classifications.
- Staff advised that the Bike Master Plan is currently in development.

**New Business**

- Discussion regarding publishing Board zones and member emails on the city website.
- Staff confirmed zones are already listed online and will verify publication of emails with the City Clerk.

**Secretary Items - Traffic & Transportation Projects**

- Citywide traffic calming efforts continue in Zones 4 and 5.
- Ballots for permanent traffic calming devices in Zone 4 were mailed to residents; construction is anticipated this summer if approved.
- A community meeting for Zone 5 is planned for May.
- DRC link continues to be distributed via email.

**Old Business**

- Coral Gables Police continue educating food delivery drivers regarding enforcement and compliance.
- Board approved nomination of Carlos Musso as the "Board as a Whole" member for Zone 6.
- Board voted to pursue City Commission funding for a study of a scramble crosswalk at Miracle Mile and Ponce de Leon Boulevard.
- Sgt. Diaz advised food delivery bots to have caused only minor issues, primarily getting stuck in landscaped areas.
- Meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM.
