RESOLUTION 2024-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION IN SUPPORT OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER REGALADO’S EFFORTS TO ALLOW CITIES ADDITIONAL OVERSIGHT AND REGULATION OF E-BIKES, MOTORIZED SCOOTERS, AND MICROMOBILITY DEVICES ON COUNTY ROADS WITHIN INCORPORATED AREAS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, following the recent tragic accident involving an electric bike on Key Biscayne various news articles have indicated that County Commissioner Raquel Regalado is interested in bringing forward legislation that would allow cities additional oversight and regulation of e-bikes, motorized scooters, and micromobility devices on County roads within incorporated areas of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables would welcome the ability to work closely with Miami-Dade County to ensure the safety of all users of Miami-Dade County roads within the City of Coral Gables and supports the effort to allow the City the opportunity to regulate those devices on County roads within the City of Coral Gables.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission expresses its support of County Commissioner Regalado’s efforts to allow cities additional oversight and regulation of e-bikes, motorized scooters, and micromobility devices on County roads within incorporated areas of the County.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
