RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE PARKING CASHIER SERVICES CONTRACT TO IMPARK PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-828 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) 2008-12-01 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$297,286.58 (TWO HUNDRED NINETY SEVENTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY SIX DOLLARS AND FIFTY EIGHT CENTS) PER YEAR. FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A THREE (3) YEAR CONTRACT WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO (2) ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR PERIODS.

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2008 the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised, issued and distributed the Parking Cashier Services Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 2008-12-01 and,

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2009 eight (8) responses were received; Impark, Standard Parking, Central Parking, Laz Parking, and Ampco Parking, Five Star Parking, Sereca Parking and one (1) no bid from Denison Parking and,

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2009 the Selection Committee completed their evaluation based on Experience of Proposer, Experience of Key Personnel, Methodology and Approach to Management of Services, Hourly Billing Rate, Past Performance and Presentation and ranked/selected Impark and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. That the City of Coral Gables Commission accept the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer pursuant to Section 2-828 of the Procurement Code and Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 2008-12-01 to select Impark for the Parking Cashier Services. Further authorizing the City Manager to execute a three (3) year contract with an option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. This service will be funded by the Parking Department.

Section 2. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
