On behalf of the City of Coral Gables Public Works Department, this memorandum serves as a notice of “No objection” to the alley vacation request submitted on September 3, 2021 by Mr. Joe Jimenez on behalf of the applicant C/LE Jeune, LLC. The alley requested for vacation is described as the 300 foot portion of the east-west alley in Block 10 of Coral Gables Craft Section. Please note that this “No objection” is contingent upon the approval of the alley vacation ordinance currently under development and satisfaction of all conditions listed in said ordinance; and on the relocation of the existing utilities including the sewer main located in the alley. The currently proposed easement does not meet the minimum clearance requirements for the sewer main installation.

The trip generation study prepared by the Applicant’s consultant has yielded less than 50 added new peak hour two-way trips to or from the site, thus per City Ordinance 2018-09 an independent traffic impact study is not required. However, the proposed improvements along Salzedo Street will require a traffic study due to the proposed elimination of a travel lane.
