Resolution of Condolence

*A Resolution of Condolence on behalf of the City of Coral Gables,
extending its heartfelt sympathy to the bereaved family of the late
Edwina Winifred Marie Davies Prime.*

WHEREAS, born on November 24, 1935, in Nassau Bahamas, the first and only daughter from the union of Samuel Edwin Price Davies and Doris Winifred Sturup-Davies. Edwina excelled in all areas of her academic studies. She graduated from high school and was awarded a scholarship to attend Bethune College (now Bethune-Cookman University), and further pursued her advanced studies at Tuskegee Institute (now Tuskegee University); and

WHEREAS, while attending Tuskegee Institute, she met her future husband Carl Prime. Edwina and Carl were married on December 28, 1960, at St. Barnabas Church, Nassau Bahamas. This most loving union produced three children: Carl Leon Prime, Winifred Marie Prime and Edwin James Prime. Edwina and Carl were blessed with forty-nine years of sacred and holy matrimony, until his transition in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Edwina was the consummate professional, working diligently for forty-four years at Jackson Memorial Hospital, Miami, Florida, beloved and respected by all those she worked with, before retiring in 2000; and

WHEREAS, Edwina was a woman of faith, who was involved in her church, its leadership, restoration, food pantry and endowment committees; and

WHEREAS, Edwina was a cherished leader who cared deeply for her Coral Gables Community, volunteering her time serving on the Lola B. Walker Homeowner's Association, facilitating outreach programs with the Coral Gables Community Foundation, working with Coral Gables leaders on civic projects, as well as with the Coral Gables Citizens Crime Watch; and

WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that the City of Coral Gables pay homage to Edwina Winifred Marie Davies Prime, on her untimely demise, September 8, 2021;
