BRIEF HISTORY:

The Arts Advisory Panel was created to assist the Cultural Affairs Advisory Board (now known as the Cultural Development Board), on March 12, 1996. The purpose of the panel is to evaluate the artistic merit of works of art to be displayed in the City of Coral Gables municipal buildings, publicly accessible areas, and surrounding green spaces. This Advisory Panel will also assist the Board in the drafting of the Arts Master Plan and in the implementation of the Art in Public Places program. At the Cultural Development Board meeting of August 19, 2009, the following individuals were recommended to continue on the Arts Advisory Panel. Although the enabling ordinance allows the Cultural Board to select the make-up of this Advisory Panel, the Board is requesting confirmation by the City Commission. As advisory panel to the Board, no benefits are awarded for the appointment. It is recommended that the term run concurrently with the Board appointments and should therefore expire in May 2011.
