# NEW TIMES NEWS RACKS – TIMELINE



- 09/24/2025: TICK-25-09-21266 was issued for News Racks in disrepair.
- 10/06/2025: Code made contact with vendor representative, Fernando Marca.
- Multiple emails and phone calls were conducted with Mr. Marca; however, no action was taken to bring the news racks into compliance.
- Code subsequently contacted Mr. Russell A. Breiter, Director of Business & Operations for Miami New Times LLC on 01/13/2026 and informed him of the condition of the news racks and the pending violation.
- 01/15/2026: NOVI-26-12327 was issued.
- Code has maintained communication with Mr. Breiter through emails, phone calls, and in-person conversations during this period.
- 02/10/2026: The news racks have been repainted, and some have been removed due to unstable bases.
- 02/11/2026: Heard at CEB - Board findings: 30 days (i.e. until March 13) to reach compliance per city standards by removal, replacement and/or restoration of news racks / \$250 daily running fines thereafter.
- 3/9/2026: A total of 4 news racks have been removed, and the remaining 9 are under enforcement.


