RESOLUTION NO. 2010-26

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$66,200.00) FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 HIGHWAY SAFETY FUNDS GRANT PROGRAM AWARD TO FUND THE CORAL GABLES PEDESTRIAN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The Coral Gables Police Department is the established local law enforcement agency for the provision of law enforcement services within the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, The United States Department of Transportation, through the Florida Department of Transportation, has awarded funding to the Coral Gables Police Department; and

WHEREAS, The Coral Gables Police Department has identified the need to educate and enforce within the City through the development of a pedestrian educational program conducted by the Specialized Enforcement Division of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, this resolution will support the acceptance of the Fiscal Year 2010 Highway Safety Funds Grant Program Award by the local governing body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Coral Gables Police Department is hereby supported in their acceptance of the United States Department of Transportation, through the Florida Department of Transportation award, to fund the Coral Gables Pedestrian Educational Program in the amount of six hundred and sixty-six thousand two hundred dollars (\$66,200.00).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
