ITEM TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, SUNSETTING AND DISSOLVING THE MAYOR'S ADVISORY COUNCIL. (SPONSORED BY COMMISSIONER CASTRO)

BRIEF HISTORY:

In 2022, the City Commission established the Mayor's Advisory Council via Ordinance Number 2022-43. The Mayor's Advisory Council was created for the purpose of facilitating the Mayor's strategic priorities and works cooperatively with and through the City Manager's office to achieve said purpose. The City Commission discussed the dissolution of the Mayor's Advisory Council at its meeting on April 16, 2024. Pursuant to the City Code, Article III "Boards, Commissions, Committees", Division 1 "Generally", Section 2-51 "Application of Article; Definitions; Standards for Creation and Review of Boards Generally", the City Commission is authorized to review a board to determine whether the board shall continue to exist. This Ordinance exercises that authority and will dissolve the Mayor's Advisory Council effective immediately and amend the Coral Gables City Code accordingly.
