RESOLUTION NO. 2008-143

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF FIVE (5) 3' X 3 ½' BANNERS AT CERTAIN CITY FACILITIES FROM OCTOBER 23 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2008, IN RECOGNITION OF "RED RIBBON CAMPAIGN WEEK IN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES"

WHEREAS, the "Red Ribbon Campaign" week, is scheduled this year for the week of October 23, 2007 through October 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon Campaign has a tradition of displaying red ribbons as a symbol of intolerance towards the use of drugs; and

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon week is a way for communities to take a visible stand against drugs through the symbol of the Red Ribbon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.


SECTION 2. That the City of Coral Gables Commission does hereby approve a temporarily display of 3' X 3 ½' banners in recognition of this important event at the Coral Gables Youth Center, Central Police and Fire Station, Fire Station No. 2, Fire Station No. 3, Maintenance and Storage Facility.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
