**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-143**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF FIVE (5) 3' X 3 1/2' BANNERS AT CERTAIN CITY FACILITIES FROM OCTOBER 23 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2008, IN RECOGNITION OF "RED RIBBON CAMPAIGN WEEK IN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES"

**WHEREAS**, the "Red Ribbon Campaign" week, is scheduled this year for the week of October 23, 2007 through October 31, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, the Red Ribbon Campaign has a tradition of displaying red ribbons as a symbol of intolerance towards the use of drugs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Red Ribbon week is a way for communities to take a visible stand against drugs through the symbol of the Red Ribbon;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City of Coral Gables Commission does hereby approve a temporarily display of 3' X 3 1/2' banners in recognition of this important event at the Coral Gables Youth Center, Central Police and Fire Station, Fire Station No. 2, Fire Station No. 3, Maintenance and Storage Facility.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
