-Welcoming of newly elected board memeber Desmond Gonzalez

NEW BUISNESS

-Resident Participation in recreation programs

Fred opened the discussion with the specific example of Mr. Alex Sanchez who believes that our soccer program has become much more less focused on resident participation. As a result the program has become more competitive not allowing for residents to participate in the program. Fred explained that the traveling competitive soccer is roughly 44% resident and the recreational program is roughly 88% resident. Felix Pardo brought up the Mayor's concern that if resident tax payer money is going into a program resident should have preference.

Fred explained that we one of the only fully municipal soccer programs, moving forward the City is going to ask whether a player trying out is a resident or non-resident. Fred explained any program that any program or activity that is skill based my not always lend itself to residents having the best skills, he specifically referenced the theater program at the Youth center which is in a much similar situation in terms of resident vs non-resident partiticpation.

-Granada Golf Carts

Fred discussed the options for new Golf carts at Granada.

-Discussion on Solar powered park amenities

Fred introduced the idea of the solar powered bench that, immediately Carlos Hernandez brought up concerns of a very hot bench and what devices would be safe to be charging in direct sun and heat. Fred explained that he would work with the vendor to remedy shade, heat tolerance, and maintainence of the bench.
