Mayor Lago: Commissioner Anderson, do you have any comments?

Commissioner Anderson: Just want to bring up the fact that I did meet with residents that asked to meet with me regarding Salvadore Park in a couple different ways. One, the lights stay on late, and it seems to invite folks to come from elsewhere and play the drums and play the music; and the other is, we need to shut the lights off at a reasonable period of time. One thing is having a few people, and one thing is having horses, Mariachi bands and things like this. Its not the intent, so I'll make sure that I will discuss this and have planned on discussing this with our Parks Director and make sure that that doesn't happen and looking at the lighting issue. See how we can better control it. And really our parks are sunup to sunset, so I think we need to really enforce that.

Commissioner Anderson: The other is, there were some issues they brought up regarding the dog park.

Commissioner Menendez: The magic word. We finally got dog park into the meeting today.

Mayor Lago: Yes, we did.

Commissioner Anderson: [Inaudible - off mic]...want to preserve the trees, see if we can come to a resolution, okay. You're ready.
