City Attorney Ramos: F-1 is An Emergency Ordinance of the City Commission amending Section 3-600 of the Zoning Code to create Section 3-612 "Covid-19 Testing Site Temporary Use Permit" to allow for the siting of Covid-19 testing, vaccination, and treatment sites operated by Federal, State, or Local Government Agencies through February 15, 2023; providing for severability clause, repealer provision, codification, and providing for an effective date. This is an emergency ordinance. It requires a four-fifths vote and it will not come back to you on second reading. Deputy City Attorney Suarez.

City Commission Meeting

Deputy City Attorney Suarez: Good morning, Mayor and Commissioners. This ordinance would allow for federal, state and/or local governments and/or their contractors who want to have a Covid testing, vaccination or treatment site in the city, to do so kind of on a simplified basis. The Manager is authorized to prepare a simple application and then there is concurrent reviews by various city departments that are listed in the ordinance, and it would just basically facilitate that because there is currently still a demand for those services. And the reason why its an emergency is because my understanding is that there is a pending request for such a site.
