ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AMEND ITS CODE SECTION 5-16 TO RECOGNIZE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TO REGULATE PEAFOWL AND THAT THE CITY OF MIAMI ADOPT REGULATIONS RELATING TO PEAFOWL

BRIEF HISTORY:

It has come to the City Commission's attention that peafowl have become an ever increasing problem within the City.

Currently the County Code prohibits the taking of peafowl, which includes any attempts to take, hunting, molesting, capturing or killing any peafowl, their nests or eggs.

The City Commission has the responsibility and authority to regulate peafowl within the boundaries of the City and requests that the County amend its code so as to formally recognize municipal authority to regulate peafowl.
