Angel was the first unit to respond to a reported structure fire which occurred on November 22,2022 which upon arrival he noticed that the fire was caused because of a down powerline that had not de-energized which caused both vehicles at the front of the house to be fully engulfed and the fire threatened the homes there. Upon assessing the situation, he immediately asked FP&L to de-energized the neighborhood allowing his crew to manage the incident, protected the neighboring residents because the powerline was touching a fence and protected the structure where the fire had already impinged on and damaged the outside of the home.
