

CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-125

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION ESTABLISHING A HISTORIC BUILDING MAINTENANCE AND RESTORATION CAPITAL PROJECT TO BE FUNDED WITH AN ANNUAL MINIMUM AMOUNT OF \$50,000.

WHEREAS, the City owns several historic buildings and facilities, including City Hall, the Coral Gables Museum, the Miracle Theater, the H. George Fink Studio, and Venetian Pool, the Alhambra Water Tower, and City entrances, among others; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to preservation of its historic buildings; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the City to establish a Historic Building Maintenance and Restoration Capital Project to be funded annually with a minimum amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing “**WHEREAS**” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission directs staff to establish, in the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 a Historic Building Maintenance and Restoration Capital Project to be funded annually, beginning in Fiscal Year 2024-2025, with a minimum amount of \$50,000.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


