AED IN PARKS PROJECT

- City Commission prioritized the need for Automated External Defibrillators (AED) in public parks.
- Initial pilot project was funded in FY25 with additional units funded in FY26.
- Staff identified the Code Blue Smart Emergency Stations as the optimal solution.
- Each station provides:
 - Controlled access to an AED
 - Blue LED beacon/strobe light to deter crime
 - Code Blue button that connects directly with dispatch
 - Security camera connected to the city's CCTV

AED IN PARKS PROJECT

- Completed Code Blue & AED installations:
 - Salvadore Park
 - Maggiore Park
- Additional Code Blue & AED installations in queue:
 - Phillips Park
 - Rotary Park
 - Cooper Park.
- Each Code Blue unit, including equipment, permits, and installation costs approximately \$95,000.
- Funding available for six additional poles.
