Good afternoon, Mayor, and Commissioners:

Our office received a request to provide an update regarding what transpired last week, following the City Commission (CC) January 23 meeting regarding Fritz and Franz (the "Tenant"). As such, please see below:

- On January 24, our office scheduled a meeting between the Tenant's representatives and ACM Parjus, City Attorney Suarez, and Asset Manager Sardinas for January 31.
- On January 25, the City sent an email to the Tenant requesting that by January 30, it provide the city with a proposal that includes the requested/proposed Lease Term, the Base Rent and Tenant Improvements (TI) amounts, and the timeline for TI completion. However, the email also specified that any proposed TI amount cannot include any amounts needed to address the maintenance deficiencies required by the Lease including any of the existing damaged, end-of -life equipment noted in the TrueView inspection. Lastly, the City's negotiations with the Tenant will not include any of the Outdoor Event items requested in the Tenant's January 18 document (changing name of the Plaza, holding unlimited special events without fees and police requirements, and not adhering to the City's noise ordinance) as these are not up for negotiation with the City.
- Also on January 25, in order to verify the Tenant's assertion during the January 23 CC meeting that the
 restaurant did not have any Health Department violations, the City researched Florida Department of
 Professional Regulation (DBPR) records. The city found that an inspection conducted on November 15,
 2023, by the DBPR at the Tenant's restaurant cited the following outstanding violations of Florida's
 sanitation and safety laws, which are based on the standards of U.S. Food and Drug Administration's Food
 Code:

Violation Observation

- <u>12B-02-4</u> Basic Employee eating in a food preparation or other restricted area. Observed employee eating at prep area in the cook line.
- 08B-38-4 Basic Food stored on floor. Observed at walk in cooler several boxes with potato's stored on floor.
- <u>21-04-4</u> Basic In-use wet wiping cloth/towel used under cutting board.
- <u>36-27-5</u> Basic Wall soiled with accumulated grease, food debris, and/or dust. Prep area in the kitchen.
- 50-17-3 High Priority Operating with an expired Division of Hotels and Restaurants license.
- <u>11-27-4</u> Intermediate Establishment has no written procedures for employees to follow in response to a vomiting or diarrheal event where the vomit or diarrhea is discharged onto surfaces in the establishment.

Intermediate - Food manager certification expired. A list of accredited food manager certification examination 53A-03-7 providers can be found at <u>http://www.myfloridalicense.com/DBPR/hotels-restaurants/food-lodging/food-</u>

manager/

22-02-4 Intermediate - Food-contact surface soiled with food debris, mold-like substance or slime. Observed Slicer and cutting boards soiled. Kitchen. **Repeat Violation**

Intermediate - No proof of required state approved employee training provided for any employees. To order
 approved program food safety material, call DBPR contracted provider: Florida Restaurant and Lodging
 Association (SafeStaff) 866-372-7233.

- <u>11-26-1</u> Intermediate No proof provided that food employees are informed of their responsibility to report to the person in charge information about their health and activities related to foodborne illnesses.
- 27-09-4 Intermediate No running water at three-compartment sink. Observed three compartment sink/ hand sink at bar without hot water.

Please feel free to click on the active links above to the DBPR website where the history of the violations cited by the DBPR at the Tenant's restaurant is available for review.

- Also on January 25, the city sent an email to the Tenant regarding the DBPR cited violations.
- On January 25 and 26, the Tenant's response asserted that it had:
 - 1. Renewed their Division of Hotels and Restaurants license on November 22nd, 2023.
 - 2. Fritz and Franz Assistant Manager Jazmine Robles obtained the Food Protection Manager Certification on January 10^{th,} 2024.
 - 3. Chef Cesar Ramirez, James Neuweg and Harald Neuweg were scheduling courses to obtain licensing.
 - 4. Written procedures for employees to follow have been posted.
 - 5. There was hot and running water at the three-compartment sink at the bar.

It is important to note that based on the DBPR's records, the Tenant operated the restaurant without a valid Division of Hotels and Restaurants license between 1/01/23-11/22/23. Also, the Tenant's personnel did not have food manager certifications until January 2024, and since more than one certified food manager is required for the restaurant, the Tenant still has not provided the city with evidence that it is complaint with this requirement.

- On January 26, the Tenant reached out to City Attorney Suarez requesting a conference call. That same afternoon, City Attorney Suarez spoke with the Tenant's attorney Pedro Villa.
- On January 29, in order to verify the Tenant's assertion during the January 23 CC meeting that the
 restaurant did not have any Code violations, Asset Manager Sardinas, and City Development Services and
 Public Works General Services personnel inspected the Fritz and Franz space. Inspection findings will be
 provided to ACM Parjus prior to the scheduled January 31st meeting.
- Also on January 29, the city contacted the appraisers who conducted their Tenant site visit on January 24, and are working on the appraisal reports that they will be submitting to the city by early next week.
