CORAL GABLES FIRE STATION 4



\$975,000.00

Funds will provide for the construction of a fire station serving the residents and visitors of Coral Gables. The fire station will enhance response times for fire rescue services to an area of the city historically challenged by traffic congestion and lack of access to the communities along its eastern seaboard and the University of Miami.

NICKLAUS CHILDREN'S NEONATAL/PEDIATRIC CRITICAL CARE AMBULANCES



\$900,000.00

Nicklaus Children's Hospital is South Florida's only licensed specialty hospital exclusively for children and includes a fleet of ambulances that are specially equipped for children. This specialty patient transport service allows the hospital to transport children to intensive care units, emergency departments, and medical surgical units, in addition to other facilities in the community.

CITY OF CORAL GABLES CITYWIDE BRIDGE REPAIR PROGRAM



\$600,000.00

This project seeks to repair eight (8) of the eleven (11) bridges that range from sidewalk/shoulder repairs, concrete spalling and delamination repairs, repairs to rebar, cleaning and sealing asphalt, and concrete cracks, joint replacement, removal of excess vegetation, pressure cleaning, repair/replacement of bridge railings and guardrails, and sign replacement.

CORAL GABLES VENETIAN STRUCTURAL AND SURFACE REPAIR AND RENOVATION



\$500,000.00

This project seeks to repair, renovate, and preserve the National Historic Landmark Facility and will also improve the environmental footprint of the facility.

FAIRCHILD GROWING BEYOND EARTH STEM EDUCATION PROGRAM



\$995,000.00

This project seeks to equip and support 300 middle and high school teachers throughout Florida to allow students to participate in "Growing Beyond Earth." Students will conduct hands-on science in support of NASA, have special STEM experiences including computer coding, biology, statistics, and data science, and present their discoveries to their peers and a panel of NASA scientists.

\$1,500,000.00

This project seeks to reduce recidivism, reduce community violence,
and create safer neighborhoods.

\$850,000.00

This project seeks to disrupt violence in communities most impacted by violence, specifically gun violence.

ANTI-VIOLENCE INITIATIVE: COMMUNITY HEALING & MENTAL HEALTH



\$1,650,560.00

This project seeks to provide emotional and mental health support, resources, and interventions in communities most impacted by violence, specifically gun violence.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ENERGY OPTIMIZATION AT WASTEWATER FACILITIES



\$375,000.00

This project is to upgrade and expand electrical metering and data analytics at wastewater facilities to realize energy efficiency and cost savings in wastewater operations.

THE UNDERLINE MULTI USE/MULTIMODAL CORRIDOR MIAMI-DADE



\$2,500,000.00

The Underline consists of improvements to, and programming for, the 10-mile corridor existing within the Metrorail right-of-way from the Miami River North of the Brickell Metrorail Station to the Dadeland South Metrorail Station. This project will serve to transform this area into a safe, fully functional urban trail and multi-purpose recreational space.
