These are photos that I took on my weekly visit to Azure, to enjoy their croissants, can't help myself. This is your view on a Sunday, and to me, this does not resemble the City Beautiful. Look at the sidewalks, look at the crumbling nature of it, look at the parking lot across the street. That's our downtown. I think that besides what we discuss with Commissioner Mena's issue with sidewalks, this is where

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I think you need to focus. This is where its an ADA nightmare, tripping hazard. I don't care how much asphalt you put on the sidewalks to close the wholes or provide a certain pitch so its less of a tripping hazard, something's got to be done. Maybe we are waiting for the adjacent Public Safety Building is completed, but whoever owns that piece of property has to be held accountable. It is a public nuisance. So, I wanted to bring that to your attention to see if you can help me out to get as much support as possible so that we can make this a priority, because I don't think its conducive for business, but overall, I don't think its conducive for the overall health of our downtown.
