RESOLUTION GRANTING PERMISSION TO THE CORAL GABLES FIREFIGHTERS' BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION TO SELL CHRISTMAS TREES, INSTALL A TEMPORARY CHAIN LINK FENCE AND USE AN INFLATABLE SANTA CLAUS AS A DISPLAY AT 5501 GRANADA BOULEVARD, THE CORAL GABLES BAPTIST CHURCH PROPERTY, FROM NOVEMBER 22, 2012 THROUGH DECEMBER 24, 2012.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the City Manager to grant permission to the Coral Gables Firefighters' Benevolent Association to sell Christmas trees, install a temporary chain link fence, and use an inflatable Santa Claus as a display at 5501 Granada Boulevard, the Coral Gables Baptist Church property, from November 22, 2012 through December 24, 2012.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
