**ITEM 1 – CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Cruz called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Chair Cruz reminded the Board that since there was insufficient quorum, that the meeting would be only a general discussion meeting.

**ITEM 2 – APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**ITEM 3 – GENERAL DISCUSSION**

Chair Cruz discussed the Active Shooter Presentation given by the CGPD Public Information Office. The Committee expressed interest in having the presentation given to the Committee.

Mr. Daly discussed the University of Alabama study on gun violence. Chair Cruz asked that, if possible, she would like the FBI research on gun violence be shared with the Committee. Mr. Durana asked about School Resource Officers and their responsibilities.

Chief Hudak provided an update on departmental hiring. Eight new officers were sworn in and are now beginning the orientation phase of their training.

Neighborhood Safety Aides were discussed. The City's possible annexation and its effect on Police and NSA staffing were discussed.

Traffic Engineering, and the process used for approval and placement of signs and other traffic control devices were discussed. Chair Cruz discussed drivers going the wrong way on the streets. The PSI Traffic meetings were discussed, with information from the PSI Traffic meetings to be brought to a future meeting.

Homeless persons in Ponce Circle Park were discussed. Homeless persons at the park north of Eighth Street and Boabadilla Ave were also discussed.

Mr. Durana discussed the Waze app, and its effect on traffic, and traffic patterns through neighborhoods.

Ms. Busot asked about the process of adding items to the agenda. Mr. Caballero discussed a formal agenda package.

Director Fernandez discussed the "rhythm" of the Committee and a "trends and patterns" type report to be discussed at a future meeting.

There being no further business and no objections, the meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm.
