**APPEARANCE OF JORGE L. FREELAND, PRESIDENT, HAMMOCK LAKES I & II HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., REQUESTING REMOVAL OF CERTAIN CONDITION ON RESOLUTION NO. 2008-54 (AS AMENDED), PASSED AND ADOPTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION ON APRIL 29, 2008.**

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Coral Gables residing in Hammock Lakes I & II Homeowners Association, Inc. had petitioned Miami-Dade County, under Chapter XVIII of the Miami-Dade County Code, to create a Special Taxing District to provide Stationary Security Guard Service for Hammock Lakes, and

**WHEREAS**, the Coral Gables City Commission approved Resolution No. 2008-54, as amended, on April 29, 2008, approving the request to create a Special Taxing District to provide Stationary Security Guard Service for Hammock Lakes I& II Homeowners Association, Inc., and under Section 9, Item (1) of that Resolution, requested that the roving guard program be continued, and

**WHEREAS**, Donald L. Tock, Jr., Chief, Special Taxing Districts Division, Miami-Dade County, by letter dated October 15, 2008, informed Mr. Freeland that the County could not accept a conditioned City resolution to authorize the creation of a Special Taxing District within City Boundaries, and

**WHEREAS**, the Hammock Lakes I & II Homeowners Association, Inc., through its President, Jorge L. Freeland, is requesting the removal of this condition so that the remainder of the City's Resolution can be carried out.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon its adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the condition of roving guard program is hereby removed from Resolution No. 2008-54, as amended.
