

## SUBMITTAL II – EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

### II.a Company Experience

Golf Academy of South Florida (“GASFLA”) is a youth-centered golf instruction and player development organization operating in Miami-Dade County. GASFLA has been actively engaged in the delivery of structured junior golf programs, after-school golf development, youth camps, and special-focus programs for more than three (3) years. The organization provides multi-site instruction across municipal, resort, and private golf facilities with the operational capacity to run simultaneous classes, seasonal camps, and specialty programs while maintaining high instructional quality and safety.

GASFLA maintains all necessary licensure, insurance, professional certifications, and operational infrastructure required to provide youth sports programming in Florida. The academy is equipped with the staffing depth, curriculum, and administrative experience needed to manage complex youth program schedules, coordinate with city departments, and deliver age-appropriate golf instruction that aligns with public-sector service expectations.

### II.b Relevant Knowledge & Public-Sector Experience

GASFLA’s leadership and coaching staff have extensive experience collaborating with public-sector agencies, municipal golf facilities, and community organizations to implement youth development programs. This includes:

- Coordinating with recreation departments on scheduling, class registration, marketing timelines, and facility use.
- Managing program rosters, attendance records, and parent communications in alignment with city systems.
- Delivering scalable instructional formats that accommodate fluctuating enrollment while maintaining safety and instructor-to-student ratios.
- Running after-school programs, seasonal camps, girls-only programs, and technology-enhanced instruction that integrate seamlessly with municipal operations.

This experience aligns directly with the Coral Gables Youth Golf Program requirements, including multi-age curriculum, year-round programming, safe use of course and practice facilities, and adherence to participant limits on the golf course.

## **III.a Understanding of the RFP Scope**

GASFLA understands that the City of Coral Gables seeks a certified and experienced Youth Golf Program Professional to operate a comprehensive, year-round youth golf program at Granada Golf Course. The program must include instructional classes for ages 3–5, 6–9, and 10–13, as well as seasonal camps (Spring, Summer, Winter). The City requires all registration, payment, and refunds to be processed through City systems, limits on-course participation to a maximum of ten (10) children, and enforcement of staffing, safety, and curriculum standards.

GASFLA will act as a collaborative partner to the City, offering high-quality instruction, reliable staffing, professional communication, and complete adherence to all operational guidelines.

## **III.b Program Design & Curriculum**

The GASFLA curriculum emphasizes age-appropriate development, safety, sportsmanship, and fundamentals.

### **Ages 3–5: Introductory Golf Program**

Focus on motor skill development, balance, coordination, safety awareness, and introductory golf motions using SNAG-style equipment and oversized targets.

### **Ages 6–9: Core Development**

Emphasis on putting, chipping, early full-swing fundamentals, and games-based learning. Sessions include dynamic warm-up, skills stations, games, and short-course/modified-course play.

### **Ages 10–13: Core Development**

Instruction includes shot-making, distance control, course management, etiquette, and developing confidence in full-swing mechanics.

### **Seasonal Camps (Spring, Summer, Winter)**

Camps combine skill stations, rules/etiquette education, daily games, golf IQ training, team contests, and on-course play in accordance with City limits.

### **Instructor-to-Student Ratios**

- Skills stations: **1:6–7**
- On-course activities: **1:4–5**




