

**CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-91**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD THAT A BRONZE MEMORIAL PLAQUE DEDICATED TO SARAH SIKES ANDERSON BE PLACED ON A CORAL ROCK AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF GRANADA BOULEVARD AND CORAL WAY.

**WHEREAS**, Sarah Sikes Anderson, a long-time resident of Coral Gables, was instrumental in having Coral Way declared a State and Local Historic Roadway; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 21, 2013 the Historic Preservation Board unanimously (9-0) passed a motion to recommend to the Coral Gables City Commission that a bronze memorial plaque be placed on a coral rock at the base of an oak tree on the northeast corner of the intersection of Granada Boulevard and Coral Way (Ponce de Leon Plaza) in memory of Sarah Sikes Anderson for her significant service to the City of Coral Gables; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission recognizes Sarah Anderson's service to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to approve such memorial plaque in her honor;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the following wording is approved for the above referenced plaque:

This monument is dedicated to the memory of Sarah Sikes Anderson (1939 – 2011). She was instrumental in having this section of Coral Way, including the plazas, the trees and the street lights, declared a State and Local Historic Roadway in 1976. Thanks to her strength, determination and perseverance, this beautiful roadway and its plazas will remain as they now are for the enjoyment of all who pass this way.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
