

















It is for these reasons that the University of Mami is proud to host a vibrant sculpture park, which comprises more than thirty places by leading sculptors from around the world. These works are a testament to the University's commitment not only to the arts and all that they represent but also to globalism and diversity. In addition, they speak to UWs abiding interest in enhancing our local community and promoting a shared sense of pride.

The works held in the University of Milant's sculpture park were generously gifted to the U by a number of remarkable philanthropists and are available for the general public to enjoy. This guide is designed to help you easily locate and identify these sculptures, which have been installed at strategic points throughout our

lovely Coral Gables campus and are professionally overseen by the lowe Art Museum.

Founded in 1950, the Lowe is Miami-Dade County's first collecting art museum. Its encyclopedic collection comprises 19,000 works and spons 5,000 years of global art and culture. The University's outdoor sculpture park, which was formally established in 2001, is a fitting adjunct to the Museum's holdings and reflects Mant-Dade County's diverse community.



Academic Engagement

GeoMuse

In June 2018, Assistant Professor Lien Tran and Professor Diana Ter-Ghazaryan developed GeoMuse with students from the University of Miami. Using a high-precision GPS unit from UM Libraries, the program developers collected accurate geographic coordinates for the U's Sculpture Park. Upon completion, the project will be linked to the Lowe Art Museum's website and freely accessible to the general public.

GeoMuse is a CREATE Grant Program (generously supported by the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation), designed to enhance learning and engagement at the University of Miami by facilitating close collaboration and resource sharing.



Technological Engagement

Nextech

In November 2019, Nextech Imaging Solutions worked with the Lowe's Digital Experience Manager and Collections & Exhibitions team to make 3-D scans of Hans van de Bovenkamp's iconic Circles and Waves XX, 1987.

Slated for completion in early 2020, the resulting digital files and related 3-D printed model will be used as research and visitor engagement tools, benefitting the community and the University; above all, the visually impaired as well as K12 and college students.



Conservation Program



All sculptures installed on campus are carefully inspected and "condition reported" on a regular basis.

Sculptures are also cleaned and maintained on a routine schedule, in accordance museum standards.

In addition, annual assessments are conducted, with a view to identifying and carefully planning for any major conservation work that may be required.

Professional conservation services are provided by Rosa Lowinger & Associates (RLA) and overseen by the Lowe.

Art in Public Places Ordinance

Ordinance No. 2007-37, Adopted December 11, 2007

In accordance and compliance with the City of Coral Gables, Florida, Art in Public Places Ordinance, The University of Miami maintains an installation of thirty-five (35) publicly accessible sculptures. To maintain its exempt status, the University:

- Submits a Campus Art Master Plan that demonstrates all changes to the collection in the previous 3 years.
- Maintains the collection through continuous preservation and conservation efforts.
