A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION EXPRESSING GRATITUDE FOR THE WORK AND DEDICATION OF THE CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE AND DISSOLVING THE CURRENT CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE DUE TO THE COMPLETION OF THE COMMITTEE'S WORK

WHEREAS, the Charter Review Committee was convened in 2023 via Resolution 2023-267; and

WHEREAS, as requested by the City Commission, the Charter Review Committee held two town hall meetings where it heard the public's suggestions for Charter revisions as well as a joint meeting with the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, in May of 2025, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2025-89 revising the membership of the Charter Review Committee to add two additional members; and

WHEREAS, the Charter Review Committee has met multiple times and provided interim recommendations to the City Commission in January of 2026, and final recommendations in June of 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to thank the Charter Review Committee members, Chairperson Donald D. Slesnick, II., Vice Chairperson Raul Valdes-Fauli, Annie Betancourt, Eve Boutsis, Nestor Menendezm, Jane Moscovitz, and Felix Pardo for their dedication and service to the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the City Charter, a Charter Review Committee will be convened in 2035.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby expresses its gratitude and thanks to the Charter Review Committee members and, as the Committee has concluded its work, hereby dissolves the current Charter Review Committee. Consistent with the City Charter, a Charter Review Committee will be convened in 2035.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
