**ITEM TITLE:**

A Resolution of the City Commission authorizing the acceptance of grant funds to Agreement No. G24MI0016A in the amount of \$443,069 on behalf of the Coral Gables Police Department as part of the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) Program to support Fiscal Year 2023-2024 operations of the South Florida Money Laundering Strike Force; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 annual budget to recognize the \$443,069 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the program.

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

The Office of National Drug Control Policy’s (ONDCP) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) program provides assistance to federal, state and local law enforcement agencies in areas determined to be critical drug-trafficking regions of the United States.

The Coral Gables Police Department is a subrecipient of the allocated funds in the amount of \$443,069 to support Fiscal Year 2023-2024 operations of the South Florida Money Laundering Strike Force.

An amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Annual Budget is required to recognize the \$443,069 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to cover the grant expenditure.
