BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission does hereby deny the request made by Robert Fine, Esquire, to dismiss F. W. Zeke Guilford, Esquire's appeal on behalf of his client, Andres Murai.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby accept the advisory opinion proffered by the City Attorney that Mr. Murai in accordance with the requirement of the Zoning Code does have standing to bring said appeal, and is in fact an aggrieved party.

SECTION 3. That Mr. Fine's objection to same is preserved.

SECTION 4. That said resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


