On December 17, 2015 the Historic Preservation Board unanimously (8 - 0) passed a motion to recommend approval that a 2-sided historic marker honoring Frank Button be placed in Alhambra Plaza at the intersection of Alhambra Circle and Granada Boulevard for his significant role in the creation of the City of Coral Gables. The marker will be installed in the plaza east of Granada Boulevard and unveiled at the City's annual Arbor Day Celebration to be held on April 29, 2016.
