RE: Required Written Summary of Red-Light Camera Program for 2023-2024

DATE: November 12, 2024

In accordance with Section 316.0083(4), Florida Statutes, the following is the written summary of the Coral Gables Police Department's Red-Light Camera Program for 2023-2024 to be read aloud at the November 12, 2024 meeting of the City Commission. This summary will be transmitted to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles along with the accompanying resolution of the City Commission.

Between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024, the City of Coral Gables issued Nine Thousand One Hundred Forty-Four (9,144) notices of violation. Fifty-Five (55) were contested, of which Forty-Eight (48) were upheld and Seven (7) were dismissed. Two Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Three (2,523) were issued as uniform traffic citations. Six Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Nine (6,569) notices of violation were paid.

The City's Red-Light Camera Program collected a total of \$1,126,141.55, which was distributed as follows:

- Remitted to the State of Florida - \$542,903.00
- Paid to RedSpeed - \$466,084.00
- Retained by the City - \$117,154.55
