RESOLUTION NO. 2021-51

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION ACCEPTING A RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE PROCESS OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A STORMWATER PUMPS FOR PUMP STATION NO. 4 FROM BARNEY'S PUMPS INC. AS A "SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT", PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-689 OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the pumps at Pump Station No. 4, located at 3940 Granada Boulevard, need replacement due to their expired useful life; and

WHEREAS, the pumps are an essential component of City's Storm System that is specifically designed to operate within parameters which are unique to that station; and

WHEREAS, the pumps that require replacement is a 14AP Axial Flow Cascade Pump Company brand and must be replaced in-kind with the same brand; and

WHEREAS, the replacement cost for these pumps is \$82,647.40; and

WHEREAS, any other brand will result in additional cost for design and other changes to the pump station system; and

WHEREAS, Barney's Pumps, Inc. is the exclusive supplier of Cascade Pump Company equipment for the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-689 of the Procurement Code entitled "Sole Source Procurement" authorizes an award without competitive bids when there is only one source available to fulfill the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-585 of the Procurement Code, entitled "Authority" authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on contract awards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission accepts a recommendation to waive the competitive process and authorizes the City Manager to purchase a storm pumps for the Pump Station No. 4 from Barney's Pumps, Inc., pursuant to Section 2-689 of the City's Procurement Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
