## Re: City of Coral Gables Retirement System – No Actuarial Impact Letter for Proposed Ordinance

Dear Board of Trustees:

We have reviewed the proposed ordinance which would amend Section 46-27 of the City's Code to allow non-bargaining unit employees (excluding police officers and firefighters) who are hired on May 13, 2019 to have the option to purchase up to five years of credited service for all purposes under the retirement system. Members meeting this criteria will have up to 180 days following the date of completing five years of credited service and will be required to contribute the full actuarial cost for the service purchase as determined by the plan actuary. This new Ordinance language shall be repealed on December 31, 2024.

Since employees impacted by this new provision will have to pay the full actuarial cost, **it is our opinion that this ordinance will have no actuarial impact on the cost of the Retirement System**. Therefore, a formal Actuarial Impact Statement is not required. We recommend you send a copy of this letter and the ordinance to the Bureau of Local Retirement Systems.
