RESOLUTION NO. 2017-59

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000 TO AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC., TO ALLOW THE CONTINUATION OF OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE SERVICES FOR THE MIRACLE MILE AND GIRALDA AVENUE STREETScape PROJECT AND TO AUTHORIZE AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO PUT TOWARD THE COST OF THE CHANGE ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Miracle Mile and Giralda Avenue Streetscape project is the result of Community visioning; and

WHEREAS, this project includes the transformation of the public realm to create a civic promenade that will become a focal point for the region; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2016 the City of Coral Gables entered into an Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to provide professional services under a continuing service contract; and

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2016 the City of Coral Gables entered into an Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for the purpose of providing Owner's Representative Services for the Streetscape project; and

WHEREAS, the scope of services provides an AECOM staff person serving as the liaison between the City, the CMAR firm (Ric-Man International), and the Consultant (Cooper Robertson), and their Sub-consultants; and

WHEREAS, this change order provides for the continuation of such services through the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget is required to authorize the \$200,000 and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the change order;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption herein.

SECTION 2. That the change order in the amount of \$200,000 to AECOM Technical Services to allow the continuation of Owner's Representative Services for the Miracle Mile and Giralda Avenue Streetscape Project.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
