RESOLUTION NO. 2026-_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO PROMOTE INTERNSHIP PLACEMENTS WITHIN THE HISTORIC RESOURCES AND CULTURAL ARTS DEPARTMENT TO STUDENTS WITH A DEMONSTRATED INTEREST IN HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables (the “City”) Human Resources and Risk Management Department maintains an active internship program, which allows students in high school, college, and graduate schools to apply their academic skills to on-the-job assignments within various City departments; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Historic Preservation and Cultural Resources Department promotes the historic heritage of the City through local historic designations, the design review process of alterations to historic properties, the review of demolition requests for historic properties, and the maintenance of the City archives; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Historic Preservation and Cultural Resources Department is uniquely positioned to offer meaningful internship experiences for college and graduate students seeking exposure to a renowned municipal historic preservation program; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, to ensure that the next generation of college and graduate students with a demonstrated interest in historic preservation are aware of internship opportunities within the City’s Historic Preservation and Cultural Resources Department, wishes to actively promote such internship opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “**WHEREAS**” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That City Staff is directed to actively promote internship opportunities within the City’s Historic Preservation and Cultural Resources Department. Such active promotion shall include outreach to colleges and universities offering undergraduate and graduate courses in historic preservation.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
