A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00 FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) FOR THE MIRACLE MILE AND GIRALDA AVENUE DRAINAGE PROJECT AND TO AUTHORIZE AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 BUDGET TO RECOGNIZE THE \$200,000.00 GRANT AS REVENUE AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO PUT TOWARD THE COST OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Coral Gables Miracle Mile and Giralda Avenue Drainage project is a component of the larger Coral Gables Streetscape project; and

WHEREAS, this project is a key driver in the economic rebirth of the Miracle Mile area and will enhance the downtown area for residents and visitors to the City; and

WHEREAS, grant funds for this project will be utilized for the necessary improvements of the drainage system along Miracle Mile from LeJeune Road to Douglas Road and also the 100 Block of Giralda Avenue; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget is required to recognize the \$200,000 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission has authorized an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget to recognize the \$200,000 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the project.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
