BALLOT QUESTION ASKING WHETHER THE CITY CHARTER SHOULD BE
AMENDED TO ELIMINATE THE RUN-OFF ELECTION IN CITY COMMISSION
AND MAYORAL RACES; PROVIDING FOR A MAIL BALLOT; PROVIDING FOR
NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CITY CHARTER; PROVIDING
FOR RELATED MATTERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

BRIEF HISTORY:

In 2016 voters approved a Charter amendment adding a run-off election to the City charter when no candidate receives a majority (fifty percent plus one) in the general municipal election.

The City Commission wishes to send a question to the voters asking whether to eliminate the Charter provision that calls for run-off election in those circumstances.

The Charter Review Committee recommended submission of this question to the voters.

This question would be placed on the April 21, 2026 special mail ballot.
