RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES TO REQUEST AN AMENDMENT TO THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) PROJECTS LIST.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2012-62, passed and adopted by the City Commission on March 27, 2012, approved the Memorandum of Agreement entered between the City of Miami and the City of Coral Gables for the purpose of carrying out Fiscal Year 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) program projects; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2012-62 identified approved UASI projects submitted by the City of Coral Gables Fire and Police Departments; and

WHEREAS, the original UASI Project List included Miami UASI 2010 Budget Line No. 2010-3, Vulnerability/Risk Assessment; and

WHEREAS, Miami Dade County performed a countywide risk assessment that included the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coral Gables Fire and Police Departments support and seek to amend the 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Projects List to delete the Miami UASI 2010 Budget Line Item No. 2010-3, Vulnerability/Risk Assessment (\$25,000) and replace it with a portable generator for an alternate command post location and other uses in the amount of \$25,000 in order to improve emergency response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution supports the Fire and Police Departments' efforts to amend the 2010 UASI Project Update Worksheet.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1: The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon the adoption hereof.

SECTION 2: That the City of Coral Gables, including its Fire and Police Departments, is hereby authorized to request an amendment to the 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Projects List to delete the Miami UASI 2010 Budget Line Item No. 2010-3, Vulnerability/Risk Assessment (\$25,000) and replace it with a portable

generator for an alternate command post location and other uses in the amount of \$25,000 in order to improve emergency response capabilities.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
