ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY STAFF TO CEASE FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF BICYCLE LANES ON ALHAMBRA CIRCLE AS PART OF THE ALHAMBRA CIRCLE COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT (Sponsored by Mayor Valdés-Fauli)

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City is currently in the community engagement and input stage of the Alhambra Circle Complete Streets Project. The current proposed designs for the project include consideration of shared bike and pedestrian space, narrowed vehicle lanes, bicycle lanes, sidewalks, as well as traffic calming and repaving. The proposed project would run on Alhambra Circle from Coral Way to San Amaro Drive.

The City held a public workshop in September of 2019, and a walk through along the project corridor in October of 2019. An additional community engagement meeting is scheduled for January 25, 2020. The City Commission has received feedback from residents and wants to address the concerns of residents who may be affected by the proposed bike lanes.

As such, this resolution directs the City Manager and City staff to cease further consideration of bike lanes on Alhambra Circle when designing the Alhambra Complete Streets Project.
